Ribera del Duero, Rueda and Toro.

Our route travels through the heart of the Duero valley, where centuries-old wineries stand alongside bold new cellars.



In Ribera del Duero we visit family estates and iconic names such as Emilio Moro and Protos, tasting wines aged in cellars carved into the rock.



In Toro, ancient pre-phylloxera vines yield some of Spain's most powerful reds.



While in Rueda, the crisp, mineral whites of the Verdejo grape offer a delightful contrast.



Join us to discover the essence of Spanish wine!



Along the way we will savour traditional Castilian roast lamb, share tastings paired with local produce, and unwind at a wine spa surrounded by vineyards, landscapes, castles and wine cellars.

This is also a journey through history and landscape. We will stroll through the historic medieval village of Peñaranda de Duero, admire the imposing castle of Peñafiel rising above the vines, and descend into underground cellars where wine has been made for generations.



From the high-altitude vineyards of Bosque de Matasnos to the golden plains surrounding Toro. Each new carefully planned day reveals a different face of Castilla y León – its stone villages, its rivers, and its deep rooted wine culture.

RIBERA DEL DUERO



We will spend 3 nights in the Ribera del Duero, learning about soils types, the effect of altitude, grape varieties and wine styles.



Our nights will be spent in a Boutique Enological Hotel and Wine spa, visiting various wineries in the Burgos, Soria and Valladolid areas.

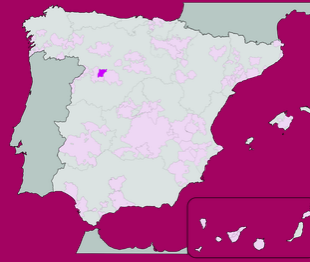
We will taste the delicious roast baby sucking lamb from a wood fired oven, local black pudding, cheeses and various tapas and Spanish culinary delights.



The many diverse tastings will allow us to understand this diverse wine region and we will also taste wines from nearby DO Arlanza and a wonderful selection of Clarettes and white wines made with the native variety of Albillo Mayor



TORO



Here, we will visit classic wineries and learn about the terroir and old vines of Tinto del Toro.



Our hotel which faces a 12th century church also has a terrace with amazing views of the Duero river.

Time to relax and walk around the historic town of Toro



We will dine in a 16th century wine cellar full of history and local stories.



RUEDA



Here, we will visit historic wineries and learn about the terroir, soils, climate and old vines of the versatile and often overlooked Verdejo grape in the towns of Serrano and Rueda.



We will visit a winery from the 17th century with kilometres of tunnels where the wine is aged in barrels and demi-johns and taste the famous Dorado wines from Rueda

We will taste a wide range of styles from Rueda .



Lunch will be a gastronomic delight of local produce, then return to Madrid
